

**Casco Open Space Commission
Notes of Site Walk, 70-Acre Parcel
July 25, 2011**

Commissioners drove to the location of Town of Casco property (Map-Lot 0002-0003) and inspected it on foot, beginning on Route 302 and following boundaries almost to Lakewood Road, then back to point of origin.

An old logging trail leads into the property from Ring Landing Road (on the northwest) and makes the area easily usable by the public, but the only parking is on abutting private properties. Mr. Kantor helped the Committee locate boundary markers; five were found, (see map).

There are extensive wetlands, including several seasonal streams and a pond that is growing-in on the southeast side and on the abutter's land. No structures were observed on the property, but there are houses and yards adjacent along the Lakewood Road boundary and construction yards and buildings to the northwest and northeast.
