

MOORING REGISTRATION HOLDER AGREEMENT:

- All mooring(s) registration must be filed annually by June 15th and buoys removed by December 1st.
- All moorings must be white with a blue mid-stripe (Maine State Law) and assigned mooring registration numbers must be displayed on the buoy (or swim float) in three inch height figures.
- Moorings must be in compliance with the current Town of Casco Moorings Regulation Ordinance.
- The Harbor Master reviews all moorings. No moorings are considered “grandfathered”.
- Moorings not in compliance are subject to penalties and/or removal at the owner’s expense.

Initial Mooring Registration: I have read the current Mooring Regulations of Casco and as the mooring registration holder my mooring(s) shall comply with this Ordinance. I acknowledge that the Town reserves the right to request a mooring be relocated or removed if found necessary.

Mooring Registration Renewal: I hereby certify that my mooring(s) has been inspected within the last two years and comply with the Mooring Regulations of Casco including gear integrity and safety.

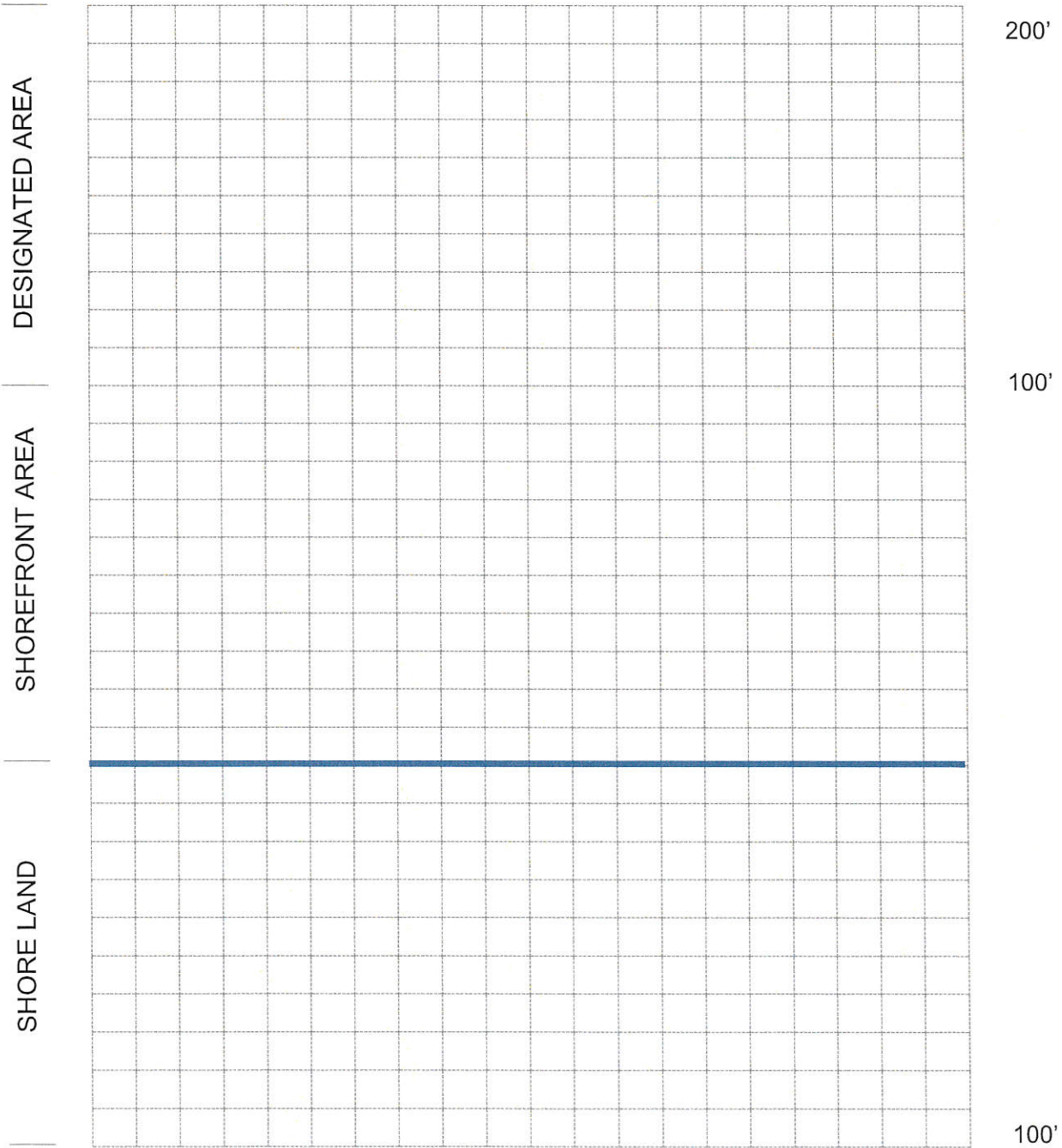
