

Pleasant Lake Dam meeting notes

Sept. 30, 2014

- Meeting was held at the Casco Community center building 7 Pm Tuesday 9-30-14.
- Introduction made. In attendance: Otisfield Selectboard members; Hal Ferguson, Leonard Adler, Rick Micklon. Casco Selectboard; Mary Fernandes, Calvin Nutting, Holley Hancock, Grant Plummer. Others attending: Peter Barber, Connie Sasser, Pleasant Lake Parker pond lake assoc., Dave Morton Casco Town Manager, a reporter from the Lewiston Sun.
- There was extended discussion regarding the lack of any current municipal funding for repairs, the appropriate process for raising funds, the process going forward to make the necessary improvements and repairs.
- There seemed to be a universal consensus that action by those present that it is necessary and important to make repairs / improvements to the Dam structure and appropriate that each community go through their respective budgetary process for asking voters to support the necessary funding.
- It was agreed by consensus the following actions would take place:
 - a) A subcommittee comprised of one member from each Selectboard and would meet over the fall and winter to develop a plan and recommendations such that a plan could be presented to respective town meetings as part of a request for funding.
 - b) Dave M. would draft a letter for both Selectboard chair's to sign asking the DEP to hold in abeyance the Lake level order of 1978 as per recommendations of MBP Consulting (page 7, item 5 under short term measures).
 - c) Dave M. would consult with tree removal; company regarding cost to immediately trees and brush on the dam structure. Dave to inform Otisfield of costs.
 - d) Peter B. to seek additional quotes/ estimates for Addressing items 1,2,3 of the MBP consulting report on page 8 under Long Term Measures.
